

There is always a need for 2 lb. bags of sugar & flour, peanut butter and jelly. rice, Jiffy muffin mix, spaghetti sauce,



powdered or canned milk, cereal, crackers, and all canned goods, especially meats, soups, and fruits. Let's keep up the good work bringing food each month for the food closet!
