



We are asked to bring food on the first Sunday of each month and place it in the box in the hallway. There is always a need for 2 lb. bags of sugar & flour, peanut butter and jelly, rice, powdered or canned milk, cereal, crackers, and all canned goods, especially meats, soups, and fruits.
