


#### A LINE FROM LEM

# New Children's Church Guidelines As of March 2017, these are the guidelines for Children's Church:

An assigned adult with 1 teen will take the small children out of worship after the Youth Sermon. All children 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and up will stay in the sanctuary for the entire service. The only exception will be if you are the assigned teen helper for that Sunday. Helpers are 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade teens. We are hoping that you will only have to serve once every 2 or 3 months. This is dependent upon whether we get the additional help we need. We are still looking for 3 additional adults to help. ### Cooperative Christian Ministries (CCM)

The CCM food pantry is located at the Leaksville Moravian Church. The food pantry is open 9:30-12:00 on Wednesday and Thursday mornings. They are no longer taking calls before distributing food bags. Those in need should just go to the church and they will be assisted once a month.

We are asked to bring food on the first Sunday of each month and place it in the box in the hallway. There is



always a need for 2 lb. bags of sugar & flour, peanut butter and jelly, rice, powdered or canned milk, cereal, crackers, and all canned goods, especially meats, soups, and fruits.

**CCM** is more than a food closet. You may also give monetary donations to help clients with medications, utilities, rent, and for purchasing extra food. These can be put in a pew envelope and marked for CCM on the outside or send your donations to PO Box 931, Eden, NC 27289-0931.

All of your donations, food and funds, are greatly appreciated.








### The Jelly Bean Prayer
